Jeremiah will be in this main room helping guests to get to their rooms of choice as well as offer a bit of vamping of his own.

We have a total of EIGHT rooms as part of this event each with their own unique activities and or performances. There are some "open door" rooms where guests can come and go at their leisure and others where the activity/performance need guests to arrive at a specific time.

Items needed for rooms may be paper and pencils and some may need you to know how to use the annotate tool in zoom (directions to the right).

## EVENT ETIQUETTE

### General

›Please be courteous and respectful of the hosts. They are volunteering their time and talents to this event and we really appreciate that.

›Please be courteous and respectful to other guests. Including being aware of younger guests in the room with you.

›Cameras can be on or off depending on the room activity. If your host asks to have cameras on we ask you to cooperate so they can run their activity to the fullest extent.

›Muting is particular to each room so please see below

### FOR Performances

›Always mute yourself except to applause then please by all means unmute so the performers can hear you. :)

›Never use the annotation tool in performances unless asked to do so

### Drawing / Art Activities

›Since the event is all ages we ask that participants avoid any excessive violence or gore in their drawings.

›Some drawing will be on your own, some together so make sure to follow the guidance of your host for which is expected.

›Some activities will need you to use the annotate feature in zoom. Please make sure to only use the annotate feature when your host requests it. Basic annotate directions: once your host has shared their screen you can go to view, choose ANNOTATE and you will have a new tool bar pop up with options. Sadly, the annotation tool does not work on chromebooks so you may want to plan to have paper and markers/pencils to join in.
